What is the vision of Adult & Teen Challenge USA?

What are the primary duties of the President of ATCUSA?

The President is responsible for providing spiritual leadership; visionary, strategic thinking; fund raising development and expansion; planning and organizational management and change leadership for a network of 85 U.S. based, independent, religious, non-profit (501c3) corporations. He/she works closely with an active board to implement an aggressive and visionary 5-year plan.

What is the projected timeline for the search process?

- a. September 4 to October 12, 2018 – Open application period
- b. October 5 to November 9, 2018 – Application review period
- c. November 9 to December 14, 2018 – In-person interview period
- d. December 14 to December 17, 2018 – Final candidate selection period
- e. January 1 to February 1, 2019 – Board vote on candidate.

Where is the Teen Challenge National Office located and will the President-selectee be expected to relocate?

Yes, the President is required to live in or around the National Office. ATCUSA is located just outside of Springfield, MO in the town of Ozark. Southwest Missouri is a very family-friendly area, with great public schools and a moderate cost of living. There are several major corporations located in Springfield which is the home of Bass Pro. The health care systems are excellent.

Does the position involve travel?

Yes, as a national leader, the President is responsible to be visible at nationwide fund-raising banquets; serve in representing the organization in Washington, D.C.; interface with the executive leaders of parallel organizations and advance the vision and mission of the organization.

Will there be any overlap between the exiting President and the incoming President and if so, how much?

Most likely “yes”. It really depends on: (1) how long it takes to identify an individual and (2) whether they come from inside or outside of Teen Challenge. The key is to insure a smooth transition for both the individual and the organization.

How many interviews will the process involve and is my spouse expected to attend?

The process should involve a max of 3 interviews with the last interview resulting in a Board vote. Attendance by the spouse is not mandated but highly encouraged and welcomed.

May I apply if I am a clergyperson in good standing with a denomination other than the Assemblies of God (AG)?

No. The President has organizational responsibilities with the AG Division of U.S. Missions as well as serving as a General Presbyter. This is a non-negotiable requirement.
